How do you pick (or select) the colors when you generate your SAS graphs?

- 1. Pick colors that are easy on the eyes and will make your graphs easy to understand.
- 2. Avoid picking colors on the opposite side of the color wheel. For example SAS offers a number of color palettes to choose from such as, a cool color palette or a warm color palette.



How do you pick (or select) the colors when you generate your SAS graphs?

- 3. Select colors that reflect the theme of the information.
- 4. Select shades of the same color to show different values.
- 5. Keep colors consistent throughout your graphs.
- 6. Use black text unless the background is black.
- 7. Avoid picking colors that could adversely impact an audience who possess color vision deficiencies, for example avoid using color combinations like Green & Red, Green & Blue, Blue & Purple, Black & Green.
