Ask for names of three objects learned in question 3. Give one point for each correct answer. Total : /3

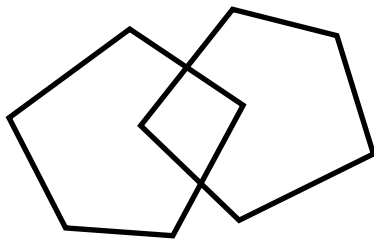

"Take the paper in your right hand. Fold the paper in half.
Put the paper on the floor." (one point for each command) /3
- 9 - Have the patient read and obey the following: "CLOSE YOUR EYES."
(Write it in large letters) /1
- 10 - Have the patient write a sentence of his or her own choice.
(The sentence should contain a subject and a verb and should
make sense). Ignore spelling errors when scoring.) /1
- 11 - Have the patient copy the figure below. (Give one point if all side and
angles are preserved and if the intersecting sides form a quadrangle.) . . /1
