
### What is SAS Clinical Data Integration?

  - Leverage standardized data to efficiently prepare data for analysis and submission to regulatory authorities




- Dialogs are organised such as only the SDTM and ADaM folders needs to be defined


Relationships between demographic characteristics and treatment group









# Visualize Relationships between Mortality Rate and treatment groups







## Visualize Frequency Rates of Adverse Events and Correlation with Demographic Characteristics




