PARENT DDS SCORING SHEET

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCORING:

The PARENT DDS yields a total diabetes distress score plus 4 subscale scores, each addressing a different kind of distress. To score, simply sum the patient's responses to the appropriate items and divide by the number of items in that scale.

Current research suggests that a mean item score of 0 - 1.9 should be considered "little or no distress," a mean item score between 2.0 – 2.9 should be considered 'moderate distress,' and a mean item score ≥ 3.0 should be considered 'high distress.' Clinicians may consider moderate or high distress worthy of clinical attention, depending on the clinical context.

We suggest reviewing the individual's responses across all items, regardless of mean scores. It may be helpful to inquire further or begin a conversation about any item scored ≥ 2 .
